

Raja Muda Of Selangor Hands Out Raya Aid To Orphans, Needy

BANTING, June 20 (Bernama) -- The Raja Muda of Selangor, Tengku Amir Shah Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah today handed out Hari Raya Aidilfitri aid to about 300 orphans and the needy during his visit to Kuala Langat, here today.

The recipients comprised 113 needy children and Orang Asli families in Kampung Olak Lempit, Banting and 151 orphans from Batu 9, Kebun Baru, Telok Panglima Garang; Rumah Penyayang Bestari Kuala Langat; and Kampung Permatang Pasir, Kuala Langat.
