

Warisan to consider Pakatan Harapan's 1MDB road show

Youth chief Azis Jamman says Warisan supreme council will deliberate on the road show's pros and cons.

KOTA KINABALU: Parti Warisan Sabah will study the pros and cons of joining opposition coalition Pakatan Harapan's nationwide road show to create awareness of the 1Malaysia Development Berhad (1MDB) issue.

"Of course, 1MDB is an important issue to all of us Malaysians and in Warisan. Everyone will want to know about the matter in-depth," Warisan Youth chief Azis Jamman told FMT.

"We will refer this matter to our party's supreme council and they will decide our next course of action.

"I believe our deputy president Darell Leiking will issue a statement on our stand on the matter."

The road show, which kicks off on July 6, will be held in every state and will end with a people's rally in September, opposition leader Dr Wan Azizah Wan Ismail of PKR was reported to have said.

The US Department of Justice (DoJ) is seeking to recover more than US\$1 billion in assets which it says are associated "with an international conspiracy to launder funds misappropriated" from 1MDB.

In 2015, Malaysian authorities opened investigations into the controversial fund but have not detained or charged anyone as of yet.

Attorney-General Mohamed Apandi Ali was last week reported to have said that he believes the US action was politically motivated.
