

Najib Gives Away Bubur Lambuk, Visits Ramadan Bazaar In Kampung Baru

KUALA LUMPUR, June 11 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak today gave away bubur lambuk (porridge) to the public in the compound of the Kampung Baru Jamek Mosque, here.

Fifty huge pots were used to cook the bubur lambuk and more than 9,000 packets of bubur lambuk were distributed to the public today.
