

UMNO Youth To Raise Issues Close To Young Generation's Heart At General Assembly - Khairy

KUALA LUMPUR, Nov 28 (Bernama) -- UMNO Youth movement will raise several issues that are close to the young people in the country at the 2017 UMNO General Assembly (PAU), which will begin this Dec 5.

Its chief, Khairy Jamaluddin, said among the issues were on social agenda, mental health and ways to overcome the rising living cost.

"We raise these issues not only for PAU but also for our operation in preparing for the 14th General Election (GE14)," he said at a press conference after chairing the UMNO Youth Exco meeting, here today.
