

Poor turnout at PH campaign in Putrajaya

PUTRAJAYA, May 8 (Bernama) -- Pakatan Harapan's general election candidate for Putrajaya, Datuk Dr Samsu Adabi Mamat, failed to draw the crowd to his election campaign at the federal government administrative capital tonight.

The programme, which began at 7 pm with a group Maghrib prayers at Precinct 14, was attended by less than 50 people.

There were empty seats even when the message from Pakatan Harapan chairman Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad was beamed live onto a large screen at the event.

Samsu Adabi is up against Datuk Seri Tengku Adnan Tengku Mansor of the Barisan Nasional and Zainal Abidin Kidam of PAS in a three-cornered contest for the seat last held by Tengku Adnan.
