

"We have no AG at the moment" - Dr M

PETALING JAYA, May 12 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad today said the country currently 'has no Attorney-General', and that several names were being considered for the post.

Dr Mahathir noted that certain restrictions had been placed on a number of people who might have been involved in wrongdoings or in making wrong decisions under the previous administration.

"So, at the moment we have no AG. We're considering names but we have to study the suitability of the candidates," the Parti Pribumi Bersatu Malaysia chairman told a news conference after chairing a meeting of the Pakatan Harapan Presidential Council here.

Dr Mahathir was reported to have said yesterday said that the government would investigate certain agencies as well as the roles of people such as the AG with the intention of going after those who had shown a tendency to be corrupt or who had committed corrupt acts.
