

Govt not blowing own trumpet over implementation of programmes – Najib

KUALA LUMPUR, March 23 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak has stressed that programmes implemented by the government are for the people's benefit and not 'syok sendiri' (to blow one's trumpet).

He said the programmes benefited the people at various levels, both in urban and rural areas.

For example, he said, as a result of the implementation of various public transportation development, a total of 1.2 million people nationwide enjoyed the facility daily, including 120,000 people using the latest government project, namely Mass Rapid Transit.

"Fishermen also receive RM300 a month, while seven million people receive BR1M, and all these have positive impact on the people," Najib told a dialogue session held in conjunction with the launch of the National Transformation Programme (NTP) Annual Report 2017 Review here tonight.

He said this in reply to a question on whether the government was 'blowing its own trumpet' over the implementation of programmes which allegedly were not enjoyed by the people.

The session was moderated by Adviser to the Prime Minister for NTP, Datuk Seri Idris Jala.
