

**Proposal limiting tenure of PM, MB, CM needs amendment to constitution - Mahathir

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 18 (Bernama) -- Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad said the proposal to limit the tenure of the prime minister, menteri besar and chief ministers to only two terms will involve amendments to the constitution.

The Prime Minister said the same applies to a few other announcements made during the tabling of the Mid-Term Review of the 11th Malaysia Plan (2016-2020) today.

“We want to take them together; some laws may have to be changed,” he told a press conference after tabling the review for more than an hour in the Dewan Rakyat.

Asked whether the government is confident that it can convince the opposition MPs to support the amendments as some of them may need a two-thirds majority vote, Dr Mahathir said he believes that there will be sufficient interest among them.

On rumours that there will be a Cabinet reshuffle in December, Dr Mahathir said in jest that he is not sure as he can't foretell the future.
