

## **Tun Mahathir takes a look at man-made Langkawi fall**

LANGKAWI, Oct 20 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad and wife Tun Dr Siti Hasmah Mohd Ali today took a look at the Langkawi Waterfall.

Dr Mahathir and his wife spent about 15 minutes to observe the beauty of the waterfall.

The Langkawi Waterfall was the brainchild of Dr Mahathir while its construction was carried out by Gerbang Perdana Sdn Bhd in 2003.

In 2004, the 66.92-meter waterfall was recognised by Malaysia Book of Records as the highest man-made waterfall in the country.

It has become another tourist attraction to the island of the legends.

The waterfall is divided into three levels where the first and second levels are built on the road tunnel and the third floor is above the rock.

The waterfall is made up of three tiers where the first two levels flow across a road tunnel with the final tier being above the rock to form a beautiful cascade.
