

Seri Perdana opens to public

KUALA LUMPUR, Nov 28 (Bernama) -- The Seri Perdana, the official residence of Prime Minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad at Persiaran Seri Perdana, Presint 10 in Putrajaya, is now open to public.

In line with the principle that Seri Perdana belongs to the people, several parts of the Seri Perdana, including the Protocol and Banquet blocks are open for public viewing.

According to its official website, the Seri Perdana open for public viewing for six days a week, from Mondays to Thursdays and on Saturdays as well as Sundays, from 9 am to 12.30 pm and closed at 12.30 pm to 2.00 pm. Tour hours will commence at 2 pm to 4 pm.

It will be closed on Fridays and public holidays for maintenance purposes.

The public can choose either to do walk-in visit or guided tours that will last for 90 minutes, though the guided tours will only be available from Mondays to Thursdays.

Visitors are required to be properly dressed and bring along their identification documents such as identity card or passport for registration purposes and no recording is allowed inside the building.

However, the management may amend the itinerary if there is an official function to be held at the residence.

The Seri Perdana was built in 1997, on a 17.19 hectares, features a combination of Malay, Muslim and European architectural designs.
