

Malaysia to extradite Roger Ng if requested by US - Dr Mahathir

KUALA LUMPUR, Nov 28 (Bernama) -- Former Goldman Sachs executive, Roger Ng will be extradited to the United States if there is a request from the country.

Prime Minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad said the action on Ng would be taken in US as the offence was committed there.

“If US requests for his extradition, we will proceed to send him to the country,” he said after chairing Bersatu Supreme Council Meeting at Menara Yayasan Selangor here today.

It was reported that Ng had been arrested in Malaysia while his former colleague Tim Leissner pleaded guilty in New York over financial transactions relating to 1Malaysia Development Bhd (1MDB).

Meanwhile, when asked on the bid for the luxury yacht Equanimity owned by businessman, Low Taek Jho or better known as Jho Low which ended today, Dr Mahathir said he had not received information on the matter.

Dr Mahathir also said in jest “I want to buy but do not have enough money”.

On Oct 19, the High Court declared the luxury yacht Equanimity as being owned by the government of Malaysia and IMDB after the registered owner failed to claim the ship and the government could now disposed of the yacht.
