

Anwar denies sabotage report

KUALA LUMPUR, Jan 4 (Bernama) — PKR president Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim today denied a news report quoting him about a conspiracy within Pakatan Harapan to sabotage arrangement for him to take over as the next prime minister.

“I never said that. No fake news will be entertained.

“What I said was that you can’t deny some elements we may not agree. That is the democratic process,” he said after attending Pakatan Harapan Presidential Council meeting, chaired by Prime Minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad.

He was asked to comment on a report in a business portal today quoting him as saying “There are “pockets, people who for their own reasons would like to sabotage these arrangements”.

Anwar, who is also the Port Dickson MP said what was important was that Dr Mahathir and he had agreed on the matter that he would be the eighth prime minister.
