

## **No official letter over king's position - PM**

KUALA LUMPUR, Jan 4 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad said today he has not received any letter or official indication on claims that the Yang di-Pertuan Agong, Sultan Muhammad V, would abdicate.

"I didn't receive any letter or any official indication about anything. So, I am not going to talk about rumours," he told reporters after chairing a meeting of the Pakatan Harapan (PH) Presidential Council, here.

He was asked to comment on talk that the Conference of Rulers had allegedly met recently amid speculation over the status of the Yang di-Pertuan Agong.

Asked whether such a meeting was held, Dr Mahathir said he was not aware of it and only heard rumours, like members of the public.

Asked if Sultan Muhammad V has resumed duties as the Yang di-Pertuan Agong, the Prime Minister responded: "As far as I know."
