

Imran Khan ends two-day visit to Malaysia

SEPANG, Feb 4 -- Prime Minister of Pakistan Imran Khan ended his two-day working visit to Malaysia, which included a meeting with Prime Minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad to discuss bilateral ties.
