

## **BPN 2.0: IRB encourages applications done online**

CYBERJAYA, Oct 13 -- New applicants of Bantuan Prihatin Nasional (BPN) 2.0, especially those in the Conditional Movement Control Order (CMCO) and Enhanced MCO areas, are encouraged to submit their applications via online.

The Inland Revenue Board (IRB), in a statement today, said online applications were encouraged at the moment to break the chain of COVID-19 infection.

“New applications can be done beginning Oct 15 to Nov 15, and existing BPN recipients do not need to present a new application if they had previously received payment,” according to the statement.

Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin on Sept 23 announced BPN 2.0 with the distribution of RM1,000 to 3.7 million B40 households, RM500 to 3.8 million B40 singles, RM600 to almost 1.4 million of M40 households and RM300 to 1.7 million M40 singles.

BPN 2.0 payments would be done in two instalments namely at the end of this month and next January.
