

Lat Am Andean Community (CAN) Ministers Meeting On Aug 22

LIMA, Aug 18 (BERNAMA-NNN-ANDINA) -- The Ministers of Foreign Affairs and Trade of the Latin Andean Community (CAN) are meeting here on Mon Aug 22 to discuss proposals related to citizen participation, water resources management and climate change.

The 23rd Ordinary Meeting of the Andean Council of Foreign Ministers will be held at the CAN headquarters in the Limean district of San Isidro, under the current presidency of Colombia, government sources said.

The ministers of Bolivia, Colombia, Ecuador and Peru will discuss the proposals related to citizen participation and freshwater resources management within the sub-regional bloc.

They will also talk about "climate change, international technical cooperation, culture and foreign relations."

In addition the ministers will meet in the 107th Ordinary Session of the CAN Commission to analyse proposals concerning statistics, public health, customs and energy.

The 34th Special Session of the Andean Council of Foreign Ministers will also meet with Representatives to the CAN Commission.

The agenda for the session is focussed on the proposed re-engineering of the Andean Integration System, the Strategic Plan for Integration and the position of the Secretary General of the CAN, sources said.
