

## **Mozambique And South Africa To Issue Single Visa For Tourists**

MAPUTO, Aug 18 (Bernama) -- The governments of Mozambique and South Africa will soon begin to issue single visas for tourists who wish to visit both countries, announced Mozambican Tourism Minister Fernando Sumbana.

"This initiative will allow tourists who are visiting one of the territories to move to another without the need to ask for the second visa," Mozambique News agency (AIM) quoted Sumbana as saying to a local daily.

Sumbana said the initiative covers 14 European Union countries and Mozambique has been pushing for this initiative to be approved by the Southern African Development Community-SADC.

"Under international arrivals to the SADC region, we have to create easy movement of tourists in different countries," he said.

Mozambique has scrapped Visa requirements for the SADC citizens such as Angola, Botswana, Mauritius, South Africa, Malawi, Swaziland, Malawi, Tanzania, Zambia and Zimbabwe.
