SINGAPORE, Oct 20 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Lee Hsien Loong has outlined three key priorities to achieve better lives for Singaporeans.

With this, Lee said he was confident of achieving the vision of providing a better life for all in the country as stated in the President's Address at the opening of the 12th Parliament.
