

Susilo Makes Six-hour Train Journey For Working Visit To Cilacap

JAKARTA, Dec 28 (Bernama) -- Indonesian president Susilo Bambang Yudhoyono today made a six-hour train journey for a two-day working visit to Cilacap in Central Java.

Susilo boarded a special train operated by Kereta Api Indonesia (KAI) at the Gambir railway station in Central Jakarta in the morning and made lunch stopover at the Purwokerto station where he mingled with the locals before continuing his journey to Cilacap, the president's official website said.

He was accompanied on the trip by several senior ministers of his Cabinet.

Susilo's wife Ani Bambang Yudhoyono who usually accompanies him on his visits was unable to make the trip as she is currently hospitalised at the Army's Gatot Subroto Hospital in Jakarta.

No information was available as to why she was hospitalised.
