

**Sudanese FM Says New Strategy To Be Adopted In Dealings With South Sudan**

KHARTOUM, Jan 3 (BERNAMA-NNN-SUNA) -- Sudanese Foreign Minister Ali Karti says a new strategy will be adopted for dealing with the newly independent South Sudan State and that the policy will be exposed to a number of the state's organs to agree about it.

In a press statement issued here after his meeting Monday with Sudanese President Omer Al-Bashir, Karti said he would discuss this new strategy with the president after reviewing it with the concerned circles and adopting it as a final strategy for co-operation with South Sudan.

Karti added that he had briefed the president on the human resources needed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

South Sudan became an independent nation on July 9, last year, following a referendum in which its people voted overwhelmingly to secede from Sudan and become a separate nation.
