

Country's image remains intact, says Najib

KUALA LUMPUR: Despite Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad's sniping from the sidelines, the country's image and ability to attract foreign investors is intact.

Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak said the Government of the day and the ruling party were strong and as such, could ensure political stability.

He was asked to comment on suggestions that Dr Mahathir's criticism of the Abdullah administration would scare off investors.

Najib also dismissed speculation by the former PM that he was going to be sacked from Umno. He said Umno had not discussed that matter.

"The only position the party has taken is that we will explain to the people about some of the allegations he has made.

"We will give the facts and do it in a very correct manner because we have to address not only Tun Mahathir but the wider population, because the people must be convinced we have taken the right decision."
