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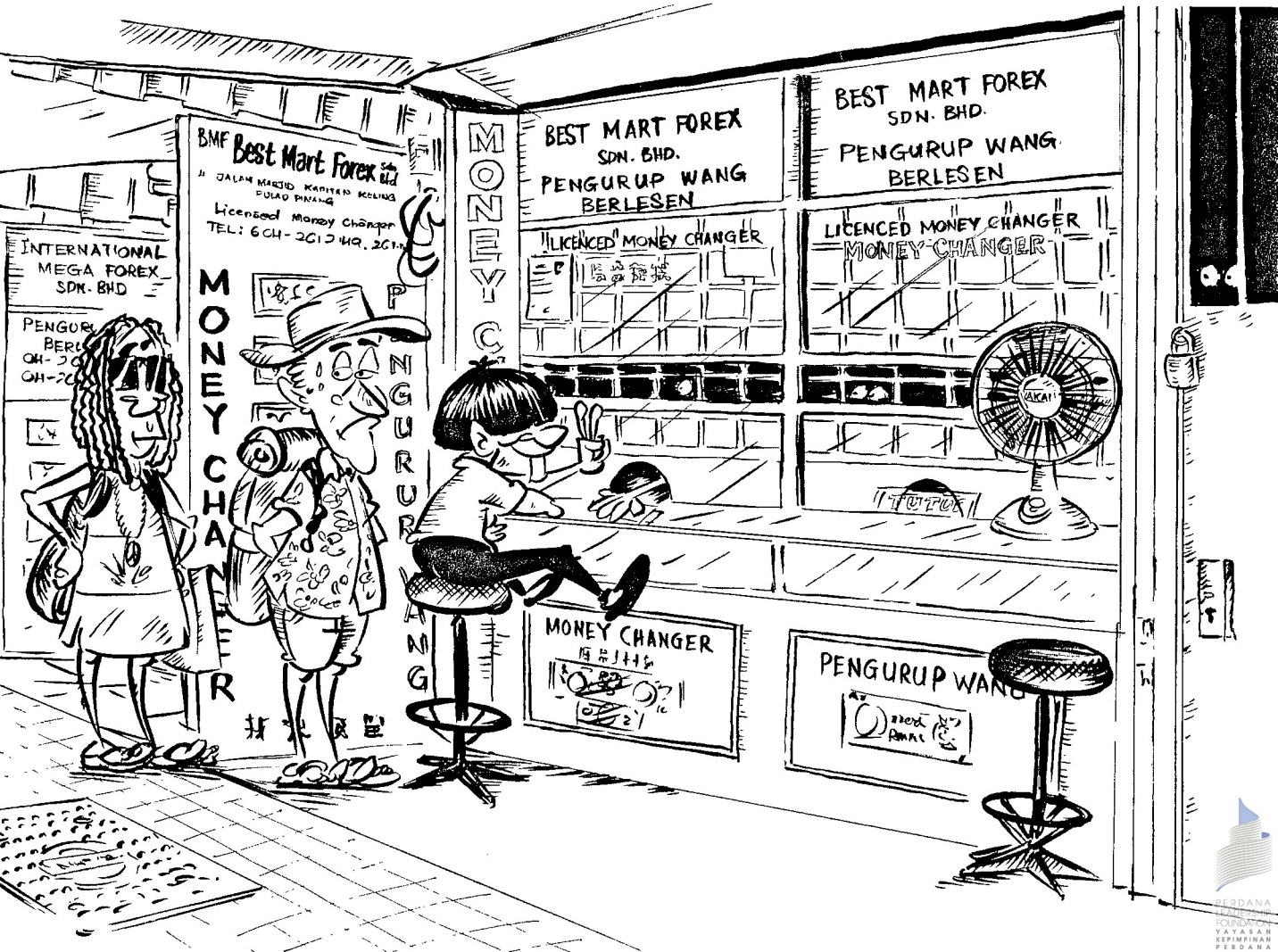

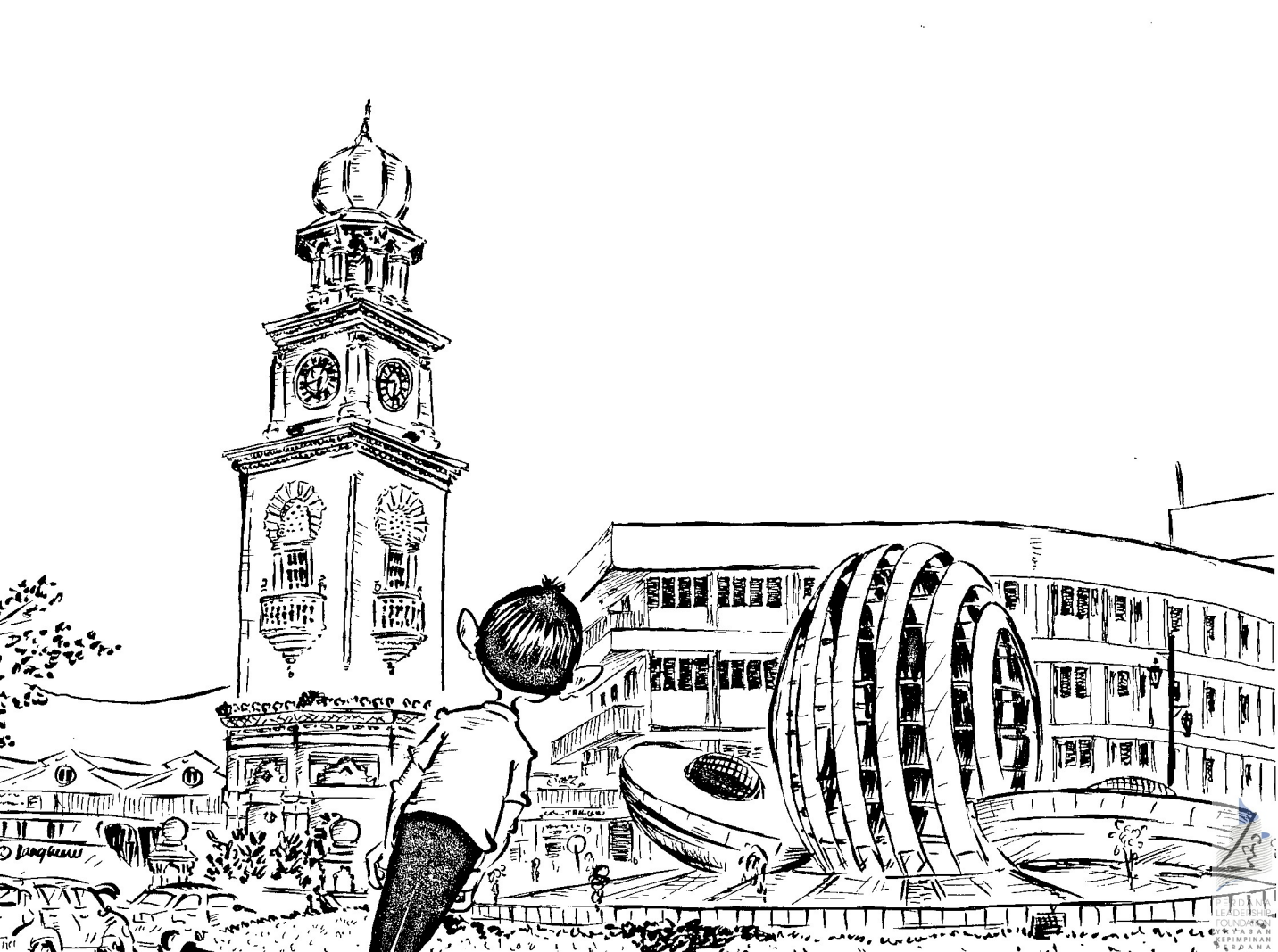
MONEY CHANGERS

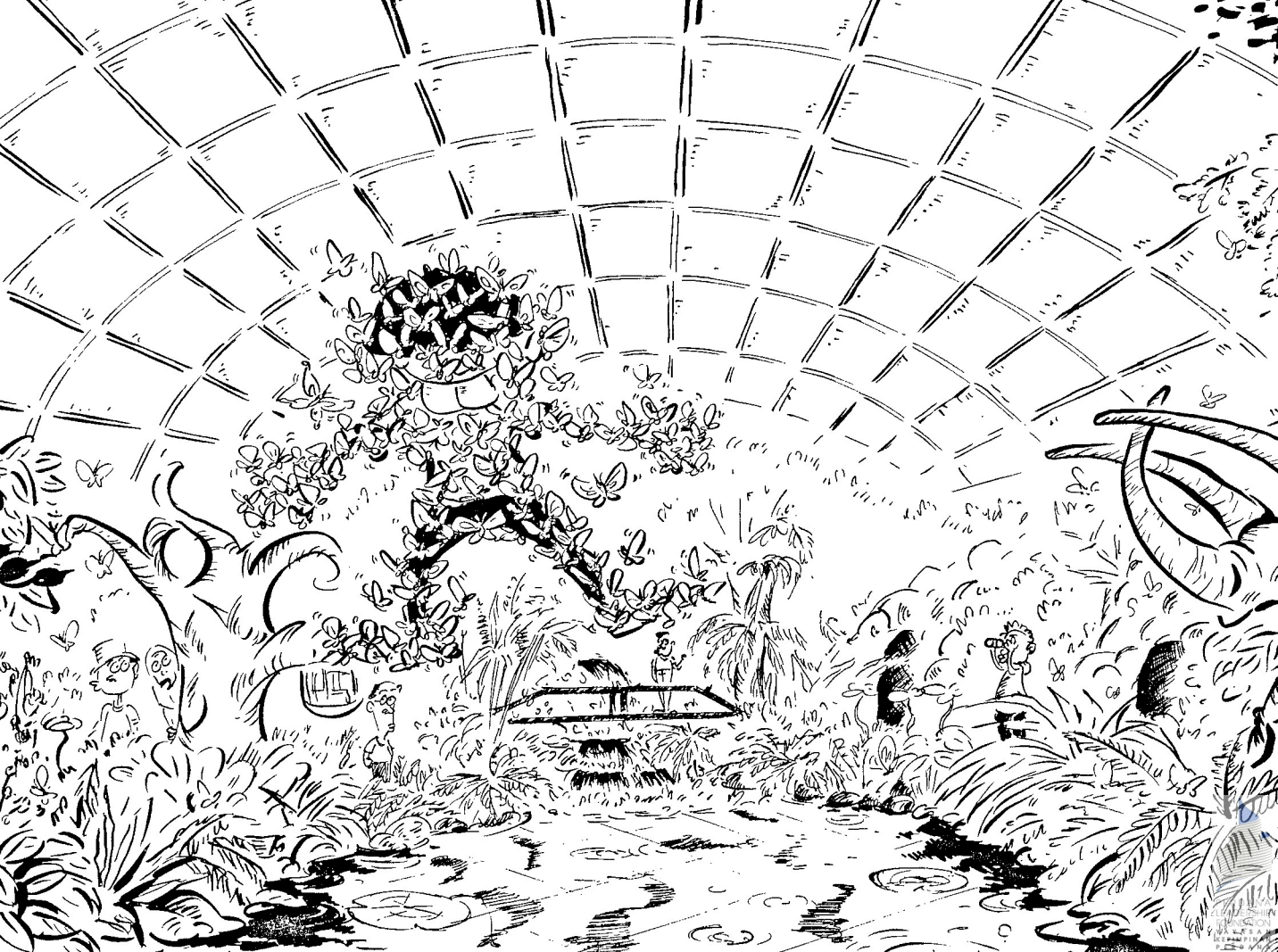
I think that the best exchange rates are offered by the money changers along Jalan Masjid Kapitan Keling just on the edge of Little India.

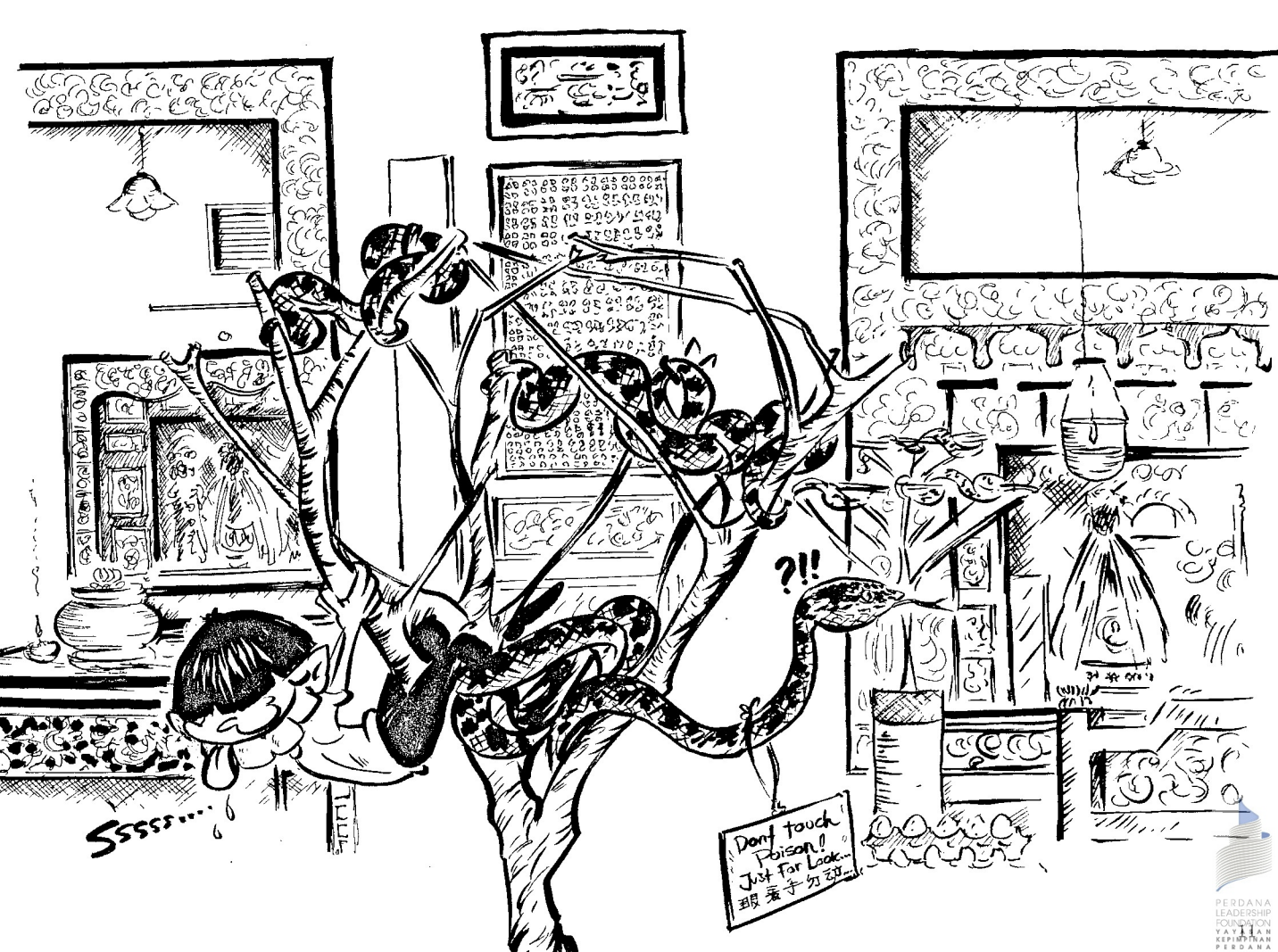


PENANG BUTTERFLY FARM

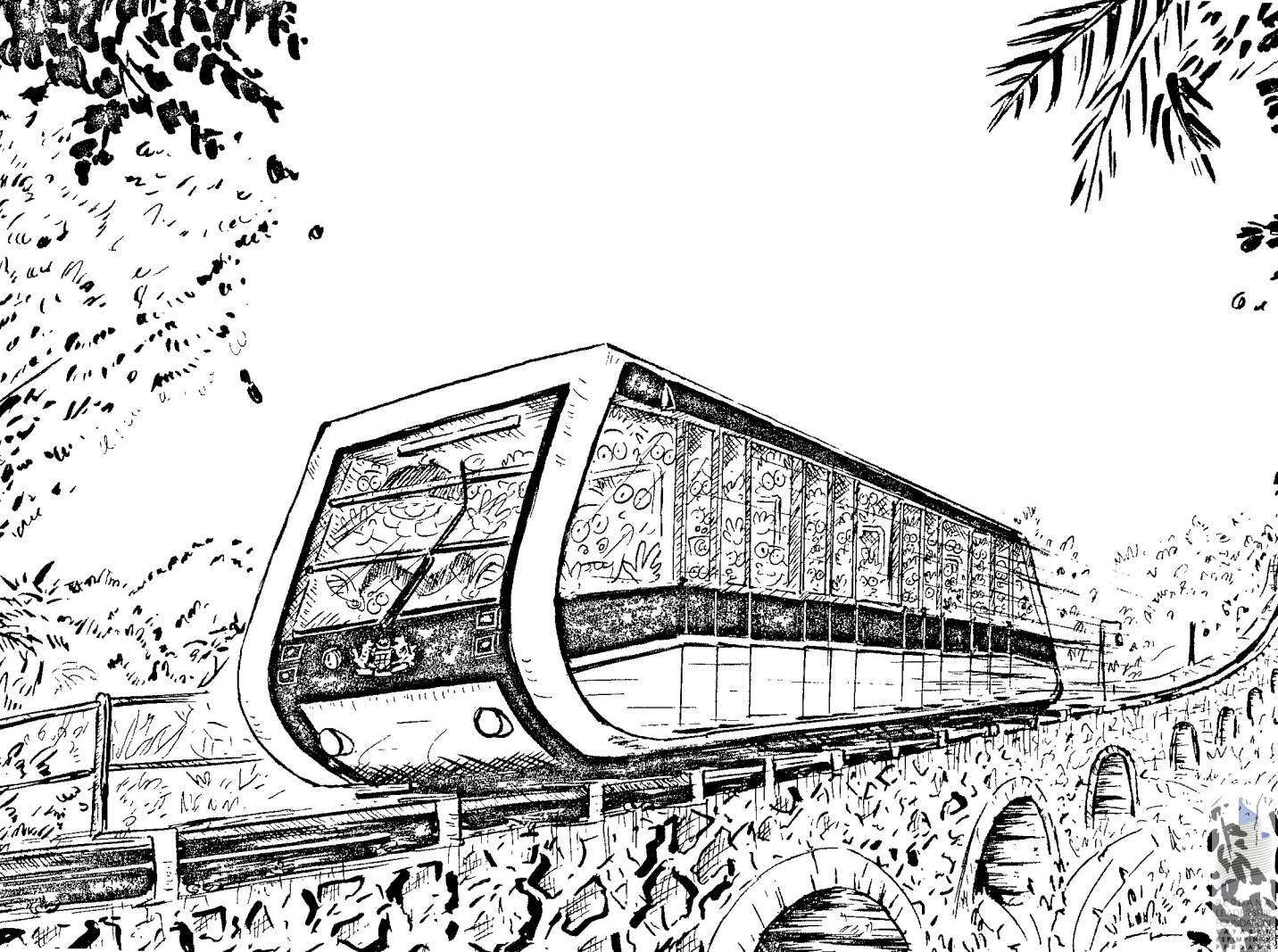
SNAKE TEMPLE

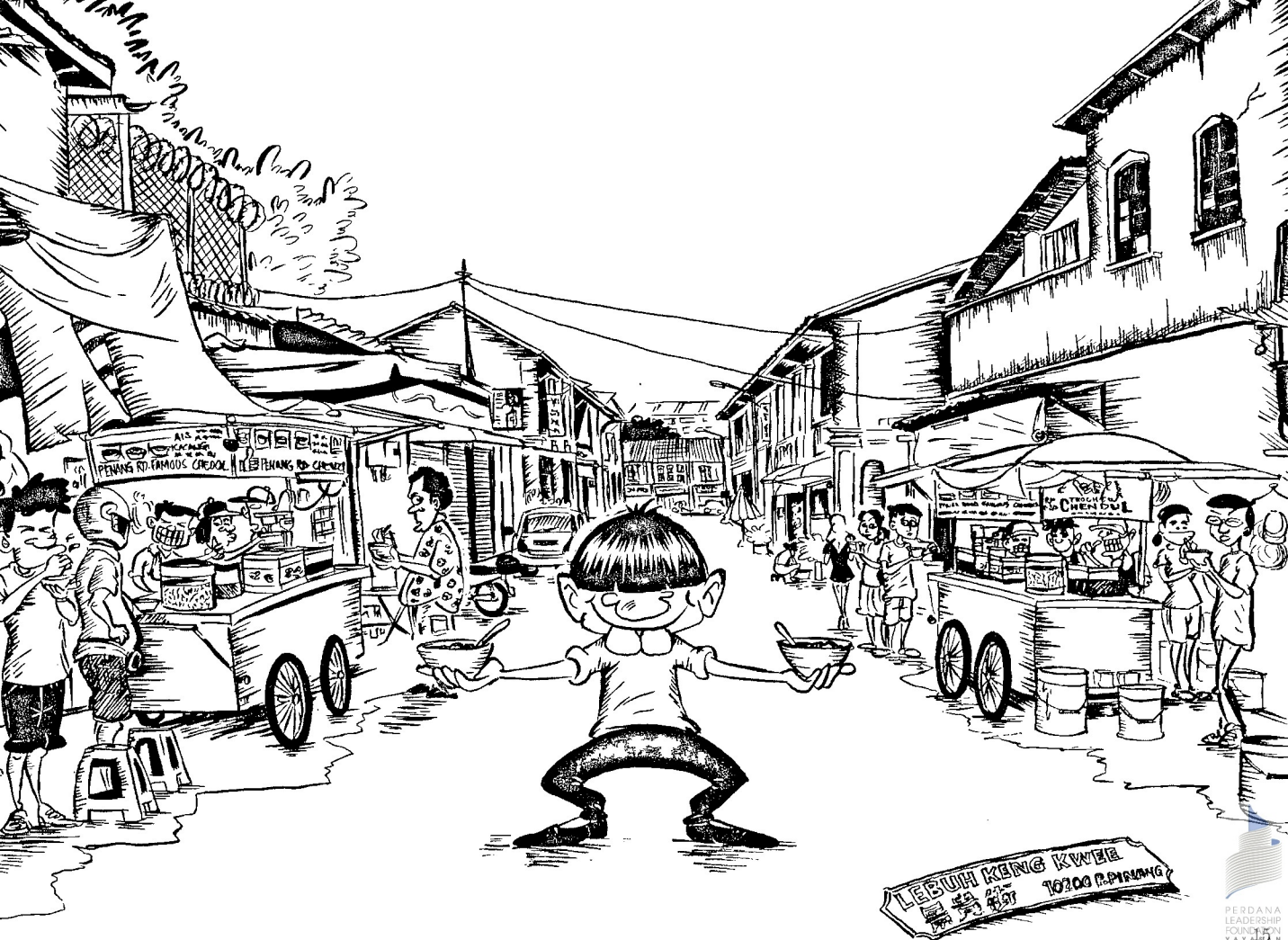
PENANG HILL

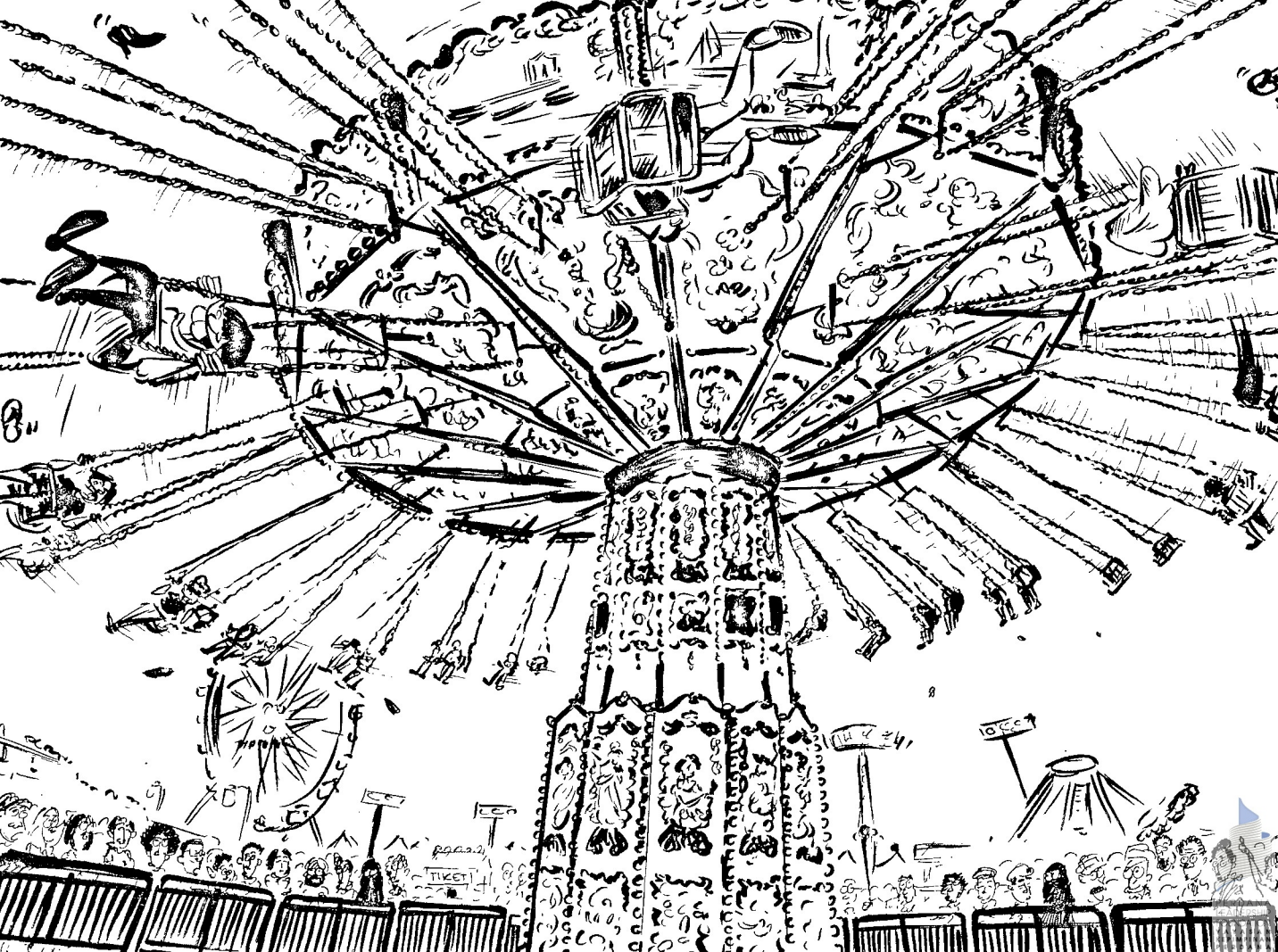
PENANG BOTANIC GARDENS

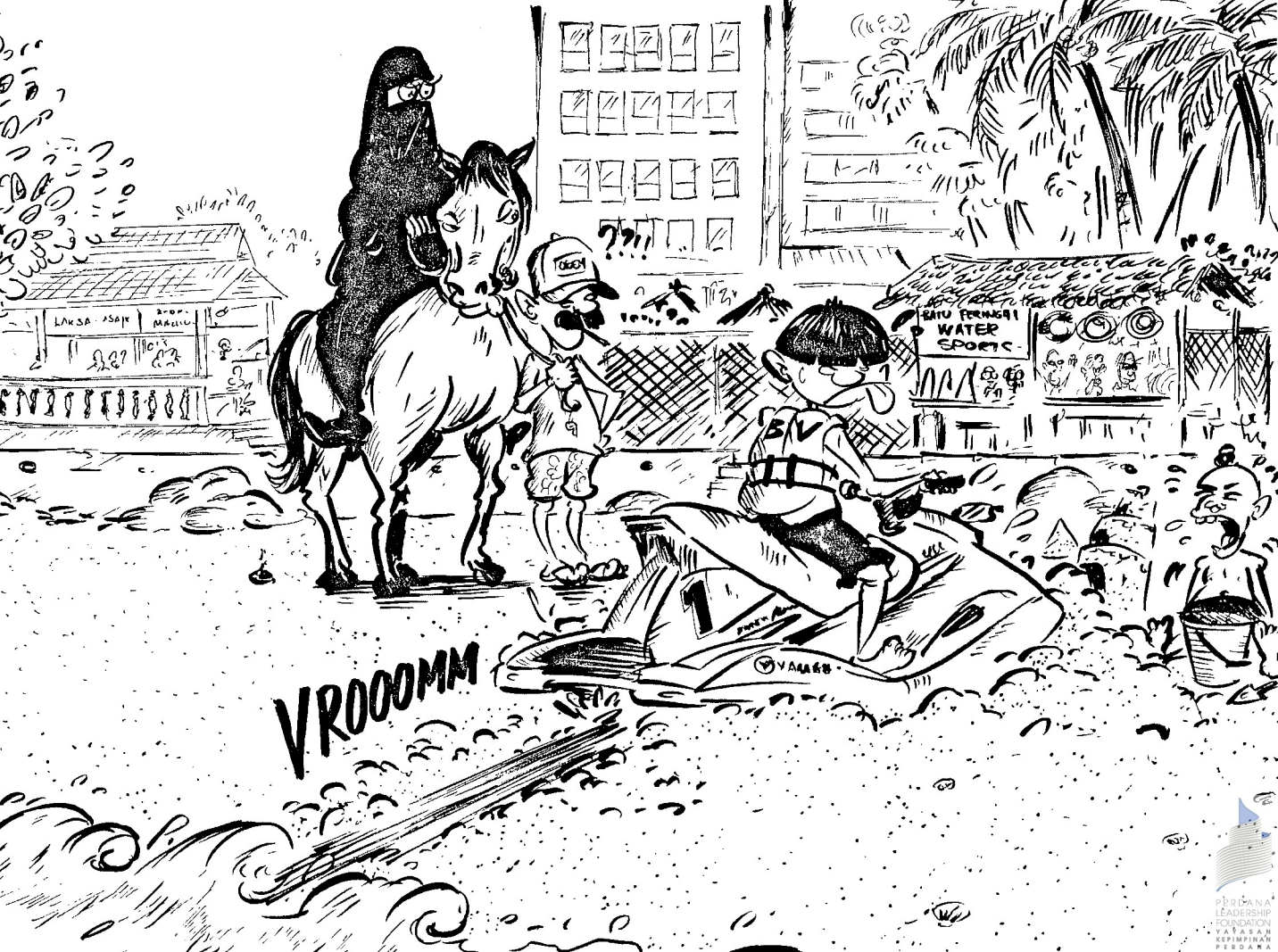


PESTA PULAU PINANG

BATU FERRINGHI

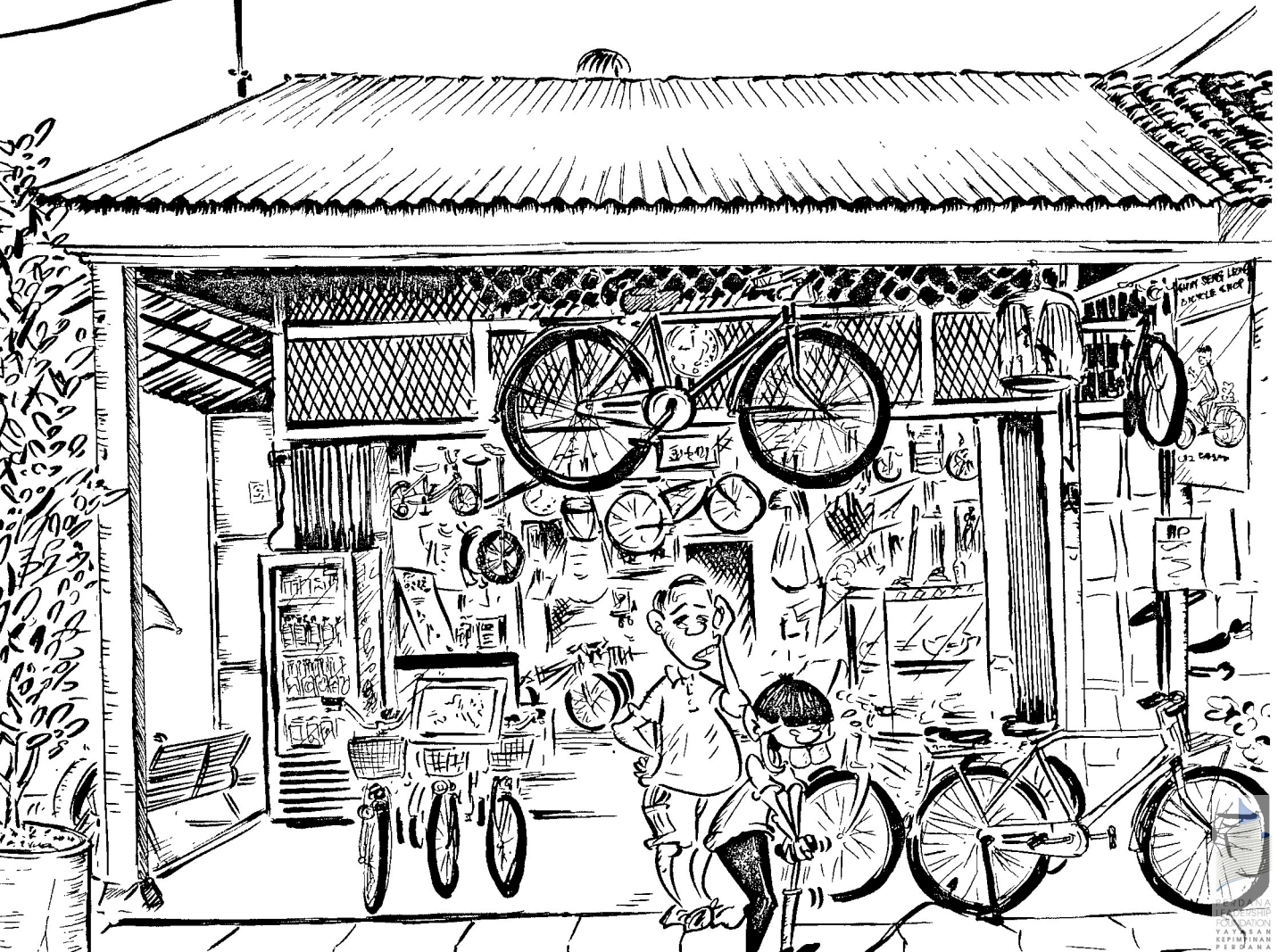

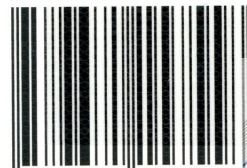
