

**TEKS UCAPAN DATIN SERI DR. SITI HASMAH BINTI HAJI MOHD ALI**  
**HOTEL ISTANA, KUALA LUMPUR**  
**MAJLIS KONSERT GALA CHARITY : "THE CHILDREN OF THE WORLD**  
**FOR PEACE AND UNDERSTANDING"**  
**23 MAC 1999**

Saya berasa gembira kerana dijemput untuk memberi ucapan di Majlis Malam Amal ini yang berupa suatu gala konsert untuk mengutip derma bagi kebajikan kanak-kanak, khususnya diwad kanak-kanak di Hospital Tengku Ampuan Rahimah di Kelang, dimana alat-alat yang boleh menyelamatkan nyawa kanak-kanak yang sakit amat diperlukan.

2. Saya ingin mengucapkan syabas dan tahniah kepada Rotary Anns dari Kelab Rotary Damansara kerana berusaha mengelolakan Gala Konsert ini sebagai melaksanakan impian mereka dan tema Rotary tahun ini, iaitu 'Follow Your Rotary Dream.'

3. Every child has a dream, but unfortunately, not every child's dream could come true unless, they are assisted to have their dreams fulfilled.

4. Some children are born blessed with all the good fortune of having everything from normal physical and mental development to their continued well-being. They have loving and caring parents who ensure that their continued growth and development guarantee them a healthy and happy childhood up to adolescence and adulthood.

5. We know that many children need special care from the very first day they were born. Congenital conditions, pre-natal infections, trauma and some hereditary conditions, afflict the children. Those detected early enough to begin treatment or special management could be saved and will survive even to adulthood.

With the advance of scientific technologies, sophisticated equipment and instruments have been invented to monitor, detect and investigate various conditions in a human being even as early as 4 months of gestation. In addition, sophisticated equipment are invented and developed into saving the lives of babies at birth and infants.

7. I certainly commend the efforts made by Rotary Anns of Damansara Rotary Club for their decision to help in saving children's lives by donating special life-saving equipment to the Paediatric Ward. They will not only help to fulfill the mother's dream of having a live child but also to give the opportunity to the child to live her own dream in the future.

8. We are grateful to the Almighty that we are blessed with a Government which has the welfare of the nation ranking top in its priorities. The attitude of 'caring is stressed in the Vision 2020. Despite the challenging conditions confronting our nation, the Government is undeterred and has devised many innovative plans to pull us through the
