

Preface

In this latest book, “Kuching in 1991”, Mr. Ho Ah Chon has compiled pictures of various parts of the city. Those of us who live here do not realise what an attractive city Kuching has grown into over the years. If we compare this book with the earlier ones compiled by Mr. Ho we can see the changes which have taken place.

With the development that is now taking place on the river front, much of what is shown of the river front scene will disappear. The unsightly godowns now blocking the view of the shophouses on Main Bazaar will disappear and will be replaced by an esplanade all along Main Bazaar from Pangkalan Batu to hotels - Hilton and Holiday Inn. An example of the remarkable change is seen on Page 11 which shows the replacement of the old Borneo Company Office building by the Kuching Hilton.

This book shows that Kuching in 1991 is an attractive modern city. When the development of the river front esplanade is completed it will be even more attractive. This book should be a good tourist guide and I commend it as such.
