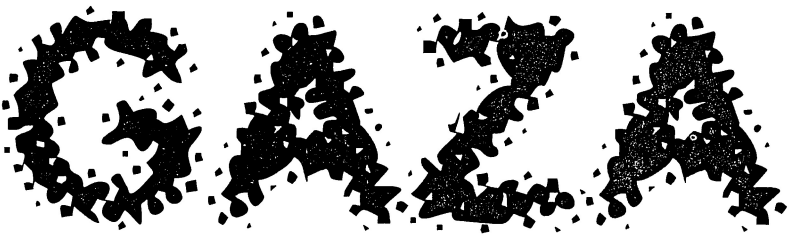

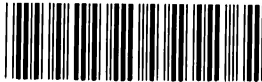

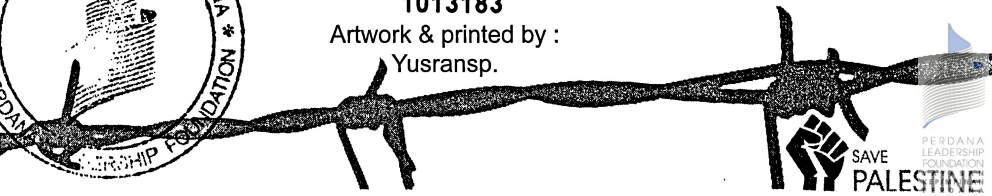

## **UN SECURITY COUNCIL MUST PREVENT ISRAEL FROM ESCALATING ITS AGGRESSION ON GAZA**

UN Security Council need to call for Israel forces to stop air raids on the Gaza Strip . Israel announcement that it had launched "Operation Protective Edge" is moving towards its third major offensive .

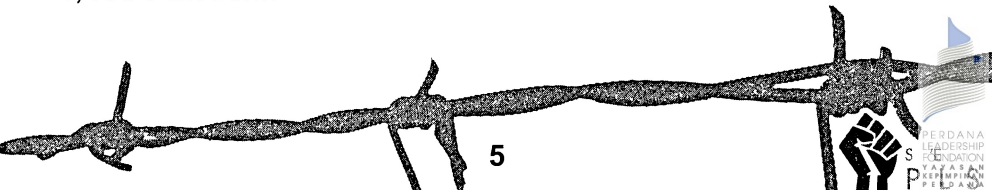
Israeli raids were reported all over the Gaza Strip, including Gaza City.

The indication of a full fledge aggression is imminent . The Palestinian officials said two air strikes were launched before dawn against homes in southern Gaza. Medics said nine people suffered shrapnel injuries.

Israel is notorius for its mass murder instinct that in all its operation it has never fail to hit civilians under its blood thirsty and aggressive policy . When the Israel forces launch an attack , there is no collateral damage , only massacre .

The Monday attack killing nine people overnight in Gaza, should be seen as a prelude to a further wide scale attack.

The UN cannot allow a repeat of Israel operation to proceed with a bombing campaign like the one carried out in 2012, or a ground offensive like the 2008-09 war which left more than 1,400 Palestinians dead.



The mobilisation of soldiers by Israel when announced on Monday is small but it will nevertheless be part of a bigger offensive.

The UN Security Council must examine every possibility of a human crisis that will repeat the 2008 catastrophe . It must demand Egypt for an easing of the closure of the Rafah crossing , less there will be an unimageble casualties amongst civillians without any outside help.

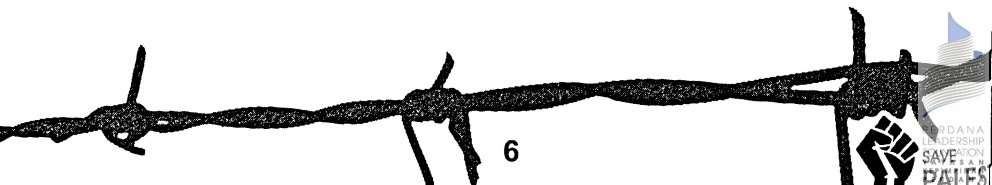
The military-led government that came to power in Egypt last year destroyed the vast majority of the smuggling tunnels between Gaza and Sinai and shut the Rafah crossing, cutting off vital lifelines to the outside world.

We reiterate our condemnation on the Israel aggression and call on all the international community to pressure Israel to stop the military operation.

We call on the Malaysian political leaders and civil society to urge for a "No War" campaign in Gaza and initiate an international call for the UN and OIC to demand Israel to call off the military offensive.

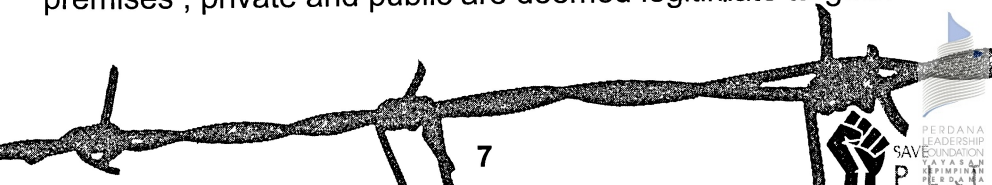
# 1.THE ANATOMY OF GENOCIDE OF GAZA

The anatomy of genocide is clearly visible in the Israeli military aggression since day one of its assault on Gaza on the August 8 th 2014 , just barely a week of Ramadhan . The atrocities inflicted on the Palestinian people of Gaza since the attack that was launched on Tuesday of that date is a repetition of the Israel military offensive in 2008/2009 and 2012 . This so called Operation Protective Edge by Israel has been announced to be a lengthy military operation .

The aggression has intentionally targetted civilians in an unlimited air strike targets and daily bombardments leaving no areas safe in Gaza. The pretext being , all the shelled locations are alledged to be hiding points of Hamas and therefore , Israel Occupation Force claimed , the collateral distruction is unavoidable. That collateral includes sleeping toddlers and children , women , handicaps and the old. All premises , private and public are deemed legitimate targets.

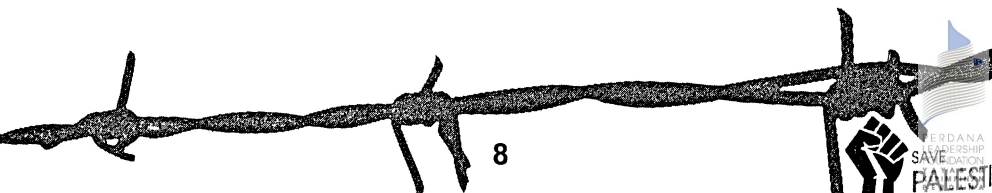


While on the very day the invasion began , all attention were given to the FIFA World Cup final , and the world community stood still when over 100 people, including many children, were slain and over 800 people wounded , 300 homes destroyed and more than 3,000 partially damaged. It is enough to touch the heart of anyone with a grain of feeling to learn that the barbaric aggression of a single Israeli air strike on one house had killed the whole family of 7 Palestinians including 5 children . Since then countless families were annihilated with impunity.

Early reports had a count of the number of target sites by Israeli jets. Densely populated cities like Gaza City, Beit Hanoun and Khan Younis were bombarded every four and half minutes . By then Israel has set for a ground assault with 40,000 Israeli reservists hovering the Gaza-Israel border . This has expected to inflict a massacre of large numbers of civilians which had translated into a figure of more than 1500 by the time this book was published , surpassing the death toll in the Cast Lead Operation of 2008/2009.

We deplore the mild response by the world community then . The escalation of the assault was witnessed by the world. The increasing number of casualties are a reflection of a numbed world community , just because US was reacting in full favor of Israel.

By the time , the Ramadhan ended into the eve of Eid , no signs of de-escalation of the bombardment was in site. The death toll rised with shocking accounts of hospitals and UN under UNWRA , designated refuge camps were shelled . The heavy casualties of civilians will bear witness to the level of carnage the Israel has inflicted on Gaza.



Emergency ward of Al-Shifa hospital of Gaza was overwhelmed by a continuous flow of victims suffering from shrapnel wounds after an Israeli air strike hit many homes. The scene of 2008/2009 is repeating itself with gruesome bodies and blood in the hospitals.

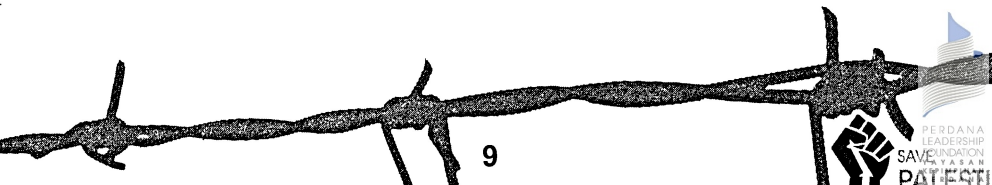
As Israel continues to pound Gaza with air strikes - carrying out 50 bombings overnight and more throughout the day on Tuesday, July 8th, 2014, concerns about the capacity of the territory's hospitals to attend to the many injured are being alerted by the medical team.

As of early evening on Tuesday, at least 12 Palestinians had been killed in the Israeli bombardment. More than 80 others were wounded, according to a Gaza health ministry spokesperson, including more than 25 that had serious injuries.

The overcrowded 12 beds in the hospital's intensive care unit were occupied and there was no more bed to treat medical referrals and for new patients if the airstrikes intensify. The shelling even targeted moving ambulances with medical workers and the wounded.

The closure of smuggling tunnels between Gaza and Egypt - the main lifeline through which medical supplies were brought into Gaza during Israel's last major offensive in November 2012 - and the closure of the Rafah border crossing, have exacerbated the atrocities.

The offensive has created a crisis on all levels.



Gaza is now suffering from a shortage of medicine and medical supplies. By the second week of the assault, Gaza is completely missing about 30 percent of essential drugs, while 15 percent of the remainder is expected to be exhausted within days of an Israeli assault. Items like gloves, urine catheters, and other medical equipment is running “extremely short”.

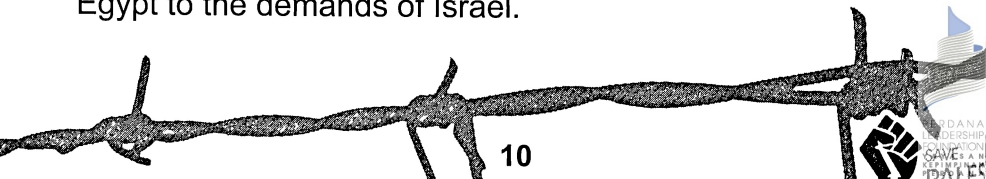
Even appeals to the Palestinian consensus government, which was formed in June 2014 month, has not reacted so far to rescue the healthcare system.

The persistent fuel crisis in Gaza, which leads to frequent electricity cuts, also puts patients at risk, especially those who rely on incubators and dialysis machines, and are admitted to emergency departments. The Israel assault has make things worst.

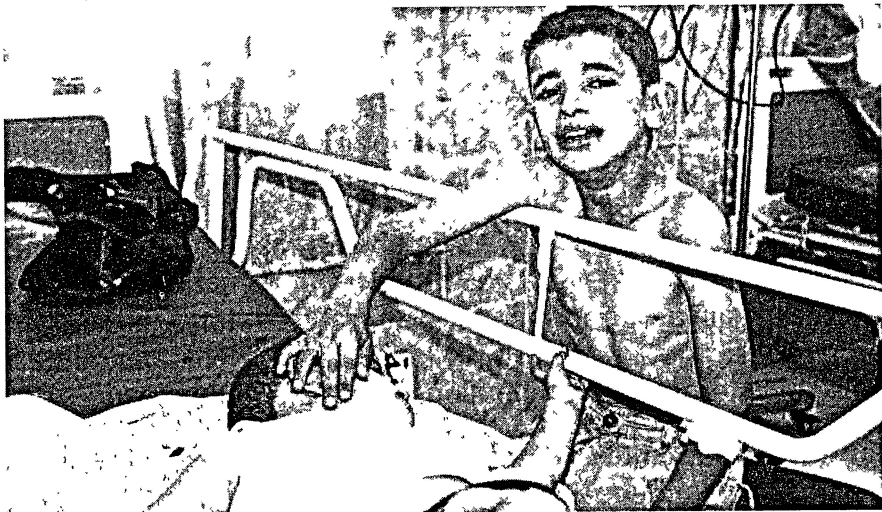
That worry became a reality when the main electric supply plant of Gaza was bombed and reduced Gaza to a brink of total black out, leaving homes, hospitals and crucial functions of basic need infrastructures like water supply was immediately cut off from the 1.7 million population.

It is clear that Israel is immune to any international law or the UN Charter in its barbaric aggression against Gaza. This offensive is not about “war” with Hamas as Israeli Benjamin Nantanyahu claims but about destroying any challenge on the existence of the Jewish state, which includes exterminating Palestinians.

The hegemonic US - Arab states power play which contributes to the Israeli persecution on the Palestinians is clear. What the world now is witnessing is the result of the submission of the United States, Saudi Arabia, United Arab Emirates (UAE) and Egypt to the demands of Israel.



Israel has been given the immunity from being punished for its barbaric behavior by the full support of the US. Some Arab states have become tools of the US which has encouraged and given Israel all the freedom to reign on the Palestinians as they wish. The UN Security Council has been blocked to act on Israel as the US threatens to use its veto power everytime an attempt to condemn Israel is moved.



In addition, Egypt under the dictatorship of Abdul Fatah El-Sisi, and supported by Saudi Arabia and UAE to the military coup which ousted Dr. Mohammad Morsi of the Muslim Brotherhood, has weakened the Palestinian resistance to the Israeli occupation.

El-Sisi's first order, after the coup, was to destroy tunnels which served as a lifeline for the Palestinians in Gaza. The tunnels were used to transport food, medicine, and other essential items into Gaza, which has been under an Israeli-Egyptian blockade since 2007. The blockade imposed since 2007 has been an unprecedented form of severe collective punishment on the Gaza people.

The world should have responded in solidarity and pressure all governments to support the Palestinian Resistance who are resisting the Israeli aggression. They have every right to defend themselves against Israeli aggression and free their homeland from Zionist settler-colonialism using all means sanctioned by international law.

The president of the Palestinian national unity government, Mahmoud Abbas, had issue a statement on Israel of committing genocide in the besieged Gaza Strip.

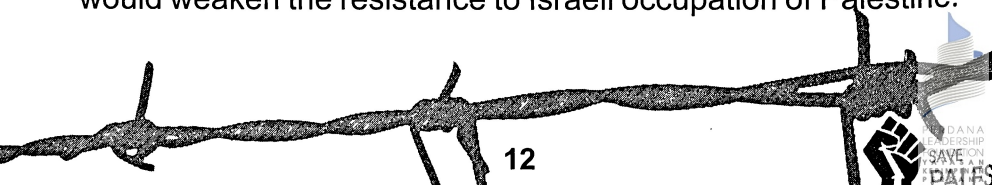
“It’s genocide. The killing of entire families is genocide by Israel against our Palestinian people,” Abbas said on Wednesday.

“We know that Israel is not defending itself, it is defending settlements, its main project. In a statement he said that “the Palestinian people have the right to defend themselves against savage aggression [by Israel] using all means guaranteed by international conventions to people under occupation.”

The genocide knows no boundaries . All those who oppose colonialism and apartheid and uphold freedom, democracy and justice must support the Palestinian Resistance in every way.

The cowardice and moral bankruptcy of some of the member-states, the Arab League and the Organisation of Islamic Conference who are unwilling to take any effective action to help the Palestinians and stop Israeli aggression , is without doubt a shameful reflection of the so call ummah solidarity.

These states are terrified of the US and the Zionists and have been colluding with them to promote sectarian conflicts that would weaken the resistance to Israeli occupation of Palestine.



Islam's third holiest mosque Al-Aqsa is located there and is now under threat of being destroyed by the Zionists.

This is the reason why the need to demand that the United Nations Security Council immediately pass a resolution to stop the Israeli aggression and attacks on Gaza .

The following our demands :

The Rafah crossing must be opened to allow access for people and goods to enter Gaza and the siege be lifted permanently.

The international agencies and governments to render moral and material support to the Palestinian Resistance and to immediately dispatch humanitarian aid to Gaza .

Civil society organisations to hold demonstrations in front of the US, Israeli, Saudi Arabian and Egyptian embassies condemning the Israeli aggression and expressing support for the Palestinian Resistance.

Civil society organisations to intensify the Boycott, Divestment, and Sanctions (BDS) campaign.



# Latest Updates and Needs from Gaza

## August 31 st 2014

### GAZA MASSACRES

#### 1. Rafah Massacre 27 th July 2014

Israel Occupation Forces (IOF) drones targeted many houses in Rafah with missiles since IOF broke up the cease fire announced by Un and Kerry; destroying them and causing varied damages to dozens of houses, also dozens of houses were destroyed or damaged from IOF's intensive shelling by tanks.

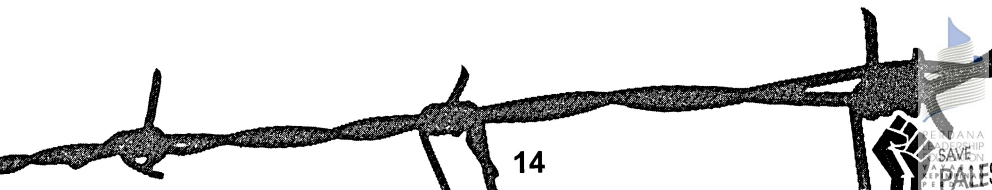
At least 100 people have been verified as killed from IOF fire in Rafah. In fact, most of them could not be identified by their own families as the IOF continued to attack people on the streets; including people who try to access the main hospital in the town. the hospital's administration have been waiting for confirmation from the International Committee of the Red Cross.

Many martyrs have been kept in refrigerators designed to keep vegetables around the town.

Rafah is totally isolated, no one can move, any object moves will be struck.

#### 2. Khan Yunis's genocide: 25 th July 2014

Israeli warplanes launched 50 airstrikes targeting houses, civilians, agricultural plots, and open areas in the southern Gaza Strip town of Khan Yunis. Israeli tanks also fired dozens of shells at agricultural and open areas. As a result, 39 Palestinians, including 5 children and 2 women, were killed.



A woman died of previous wounds. Additionally, 165 Palestinians, including 36 women and 42 children, were wounded. Israeli forces maintained their incursion into Khuza'a village, east of Khan Yunis, and there are reports that there are dozens of Palestinian casualties in the village, and medical crews were denied access to them. When many civilians attempted to leave the village, Israeli forces fired at them, killing 4.

### 3. Shejaia's genocide: 20 th July 2014



Israeli occupation forces have continued their brutal and immoral offensive on the Gaza Strip for the 13th consecutive day, and have continued the policy of collective punishment in disregard for the international law and humanitarian law, which ensure protection for civilians in times of war, and in violation of the principles of necessity, proportionality and distinction. Israeli forces have continued their aerial, ground and sea attacks throughout the Gaza Strip, causing more civilian

casualties and damaging civilian facilities, including houses. Since the beginning of the massacre, Israeli forces have launched unprecedented attacks on al-Shuja'iya neighborhood in the east of Gaza City. The neighborhood has been subjected to intensive aerial and ground shelling. Dozens of Palestinian civilians have been killed or wounded, and medical crews and the ICRC have not been able to attend them. Women were seen taking their children out to flee from the area, and some of them were killed. People who were not able to leave the area have been trapped under the Israeli selling and their destinies are unknown. At least 72 people have been killed and 400 has been wounded in Gaza's Shujayea district in the heaviest barrage of tank shells since Israel launched its ground invasion late Thursday and number increases every minute.

#### **4. Targeting a hospital**

The Al Aqsa Martyrs' Hospital in Deir El Balah was hit by an Israeli airstrike resulting in the destruction of part of the top two floors and four people were killed and 16 injured.



# Letter from Gaza by a Norwegian doctor

Dearest friends,

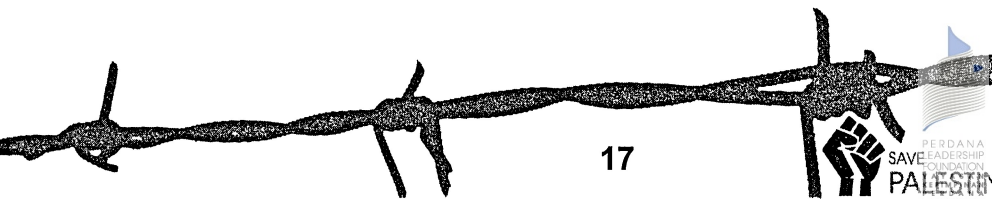
The last night was extreme. The "ground invasion" of Gaza resulted in scores and carloads with maimed, torn apart, bleeding, shivering, dying - all sorts of injured Palestinians, all ages, all civilians, all innocent.

The heroes in the ambulances and in all of Gaza's hospitals are working 12-24 hour shifts, grey from fatigue and inhuman workloads (without payment all in Shifa for the last 4 months), they care, triage, try to understand the incomprehensible chaos of bodies, sizes, limbs, walking, not walking, breathing, not breathing, bleeding, not bleeding humans. HUMANS!

Now, once more treated like animals by "the most moral army in the world" (sic!).

My respect for the wounded is endless, in their contained determination in the midst of pain, agony and shock; my admiration for the staff and volunteers is endless, my closeness to the Palestinian "sumud" gives me strength, although in glimpses I just want to scream, hold someone tight, cry, smell the skin and hair of the warm child, covered in blood, protect ourselves in an endless embrace - but we cannot afford that, nor can they.

Ashy grey faces - Oh NO! Not one more load of tens of maimed and bleeding, we still have lakes of blood on the floor in the ER, piles of dripping, blood-soaked bandages to clear out - oh - the cleaners, everywhere, swiftly shovelling the blood and discarded tissues, hair, clothes, cannulas - the leftovers from death - all taken away ... to be prepared again, to be repeated all over. More than 100 cases came to Shifa in the last 24 hrs. Enough for a large well trained hospital with everything, but here - almost nothing: no electricity, water, disposables, drugs, OR-tables,



instruments, monitors - all rusted and as if taken from museums of yesterday's hospitals. But they do not complain, these heroes. They get on with it, like warriors, head on, enormously resolute.

And as I write these words to you, alone, on a bed, my tears flow, the warm but useless tears of pain and grief, of anger and fear. This is not happening!

And then, just now, the orchestra of the Israeli war-machine starts its gruesome symphony again, just now: salvos of artillery from the navy boats just down on the shores, the roaring F16, the sickening drones (Arabic 'Zennanis', the hummers), and the cluttering Apaches. So much made in and paid by the US.

Mr. Obama - do you have a heart?

I invite you - spend one night - just one night - with us in Shifa. Disguised as a cleaner, maybe.

I am convinced, 100%, it would change history.

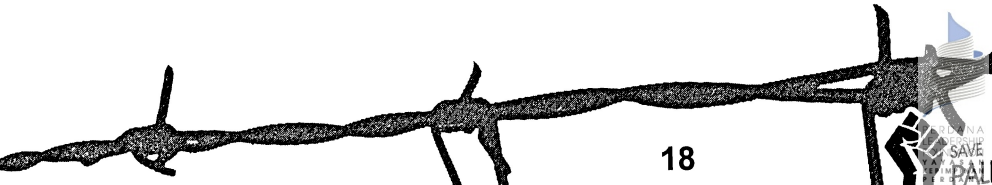
Nobody with a heart AND power could ever walk away from a night in Shifa without being determined to end the slaughter of the Palestinian people.

But the heartless and merciless have done their calculations and planned another "dahyia" onslaught on Gaza.

The rivers of blood will keep running the coming night. I can hear they have tuned their instruments of death.

Please. Do what you can. This, THIS cannot continue.

*Israeli occupation forces have continued their brutal and immoral offensive on the Gaza Strip for the 23rd consecutive day, and have continued the policy of collective punishment in disregard for the international law and humanitarian law, which ensure protection for civilians in times of war, and in violation of the principles of necessity, proportionality and distinction. Israeli forces have continued their aerial, ground and sea attacks throughout the Gaza Strip, causing more civilian casualties and damaging civilian facilities*

- As of 10th August 2014, at least 1900 Palestinians have been Martyred ( more 400 children) since the beginning of the aggression on Gaza, of whom Most of them are civilians, more than 7680 wounded (2350 children,1650 women, 320 elders)

- In another grave crime, Israeli forces killed 17 internally displaced persons; most of who children, inside a UN school turned shelter, The safety of IDPs is a serious concern with IOF attacking shelters for the sixth time today. 30 of July

- After announcing humanitarian truce from IOF side and while civilians were inside Ash Shuja'iyah market, 17 people were killed and hundreds injured in shelling of Ash Shuja'iyah market most of them children 30 of July

- Due the ongoing Israeli offensive on the Gaza Strip number of Homes fully destroyed or severely damaged are 9395 house, also 31,500 house damaged partially ( 4735 middle damage) in Gaza directly displacing thousands of people every minute.

- 153 schools and 175 service and public facilities in Gaza have sustained damage.

- 90 Masjids in Gaza were damaged and fully destroyed

- 9 NGOS HQ were destroyed



- 50 boats for fish men were destroyed and more than 200 boat were damaged.
- Initial reports about 3 Billion is the Economic sector loss in Gaza
- There are now 249,000 displaced persons seeking refuge in 92 UNRWA shelters and 70,000 in their relatives houses.
- Food shortages in the market are reported in some areas, along with sharp price increases in vegetables and dairy products.
- 900,000 People lost their access to water supply
- Electricity not seen in Gaza strip as The Gaza Power Plant was struck by IOF causing shut-down of the plant
- A number of warehouses critical for humanitarian operations have remained out of reach as well, including UNRWA's main warehouse in eastern Gaza City
- shortages of some food items in the local market have increased, and in some areas, large crowds have been observed outside of bakeries

Needs:-

## **Nonfood item and shelter**

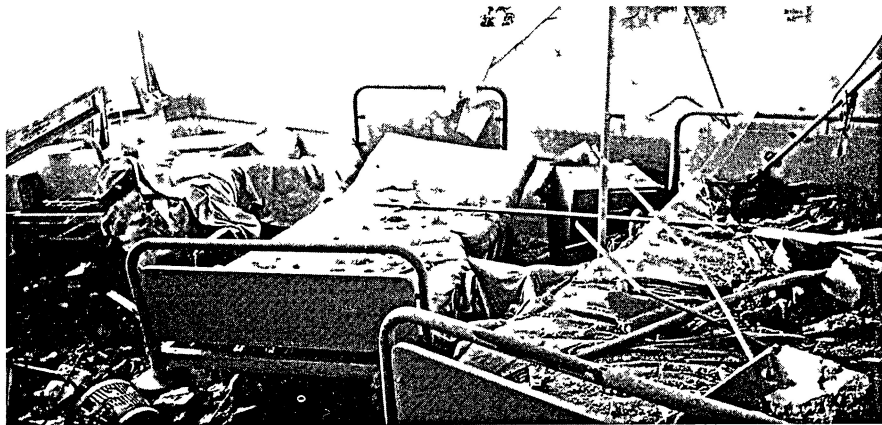
### ***i.New shelters are needed.***

- 56,350 individuals whose shelters were totally destroyed or sustained major structural damage need emergency NFI kits including mattresses, blankets, hygiene kits, and kitchen sets. In the medium term, they will need cash assistance to cover rental fees and basic household items.



- NFI emergency shelter repair interventions are needed for about 4,735 families (28,400 individuals), whose homes sustained damage but are still inhabitable. 27,050 families (162,300 individuals), whose homes sustained minor damage also require basic NFI assistance.

## *ii. Health*



- The destruction of Gaza's main power plant earlier in the week has an immediate impact on the public health situation and reduces water and sanitation services, hospitals are currently fully dependent on generators.
- The health needs, including mental health needs for displaced families sheltering in schools and other emergency shelters, need to be immediately addressed.
- Massive shortage in drugs and disposables (28 and 54 per cent respectively) at Gaza Hospitals hinders Ministry of Health's (MoH) ability to deliver health services. Gaza requires US\$ 3.2 million monthly to secure the needed drugs and disposables.

- Eight anesthesia machines, 10 ventilators, 5 electrosurgical units, 20 vital sign monitors, ECG machines, 5 defibrillator machines urgently needed.

- Shifa hospital urgently needs neurosurgeons, anesthesiologists, plastic and general surgeons, and orthopedic specialists, as well as 20 ICU beds, a digital C-ARM machine for orthopedic surgeries, three operation tables and a lighting system for the five operation rooms

### ***iii. Food Assistant***

- More than 30,000 IDPs are in need of emergency food assistance.

- Immediate emergency funds to cover massively increasing food needs of IDPs are required.

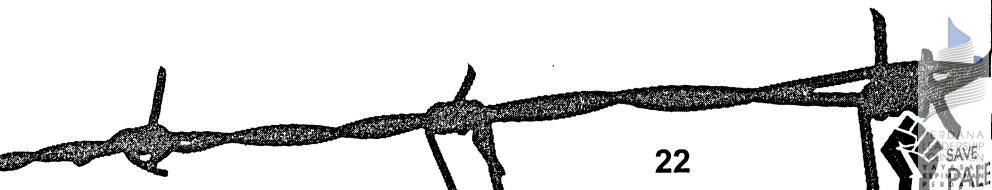
- Farmers, breeders and fishermen's livelihoods are heavily compromised. Although a comprehensive picture of exact needs is not yet available, animal feed for 3,000 herders is needed to avoid further loss of livestock and erosion of livelihoods.

### ***iv. Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH)***

- With the shutdown of the GPP, additional fuel supply to run the water wells is a key priority

- The Deir al Balah Desalination Plant requires additional fuel to resume water pumping into the network.

- Insecticides and medicines are needed in Rafah to treat epidemics such as lice and scabies, which started to spread in shelters.



- More than 300,000 IDPs hosted at UNRWA shelters, public schools, with host families or in open spaces, as well as communities disconnected from the municipal water supply need water for drinking and domestic use.
- An estimated 1.2 million people have no or very limited access to water or sanitation services due to damage to the electricity system or lack of fuel to run generators to power WASH facilities.
- Several areas are experiencing sewage flooding, in particular in Beit Hanoun and Beit Lahiya, posing public health hazards
- WASH facilities east of Salah ad Din road and in north Gaza (both areas in the new three km no-go zone) have not been accessible for repairs, while also likely to be inaccessible to water trucking due to the unsafe security situation.

## Appeal

Once more, Gazan civilians are being made to pay the price of war. After a crippling blockade and successive attacks, 1.8 million Gazans are even more defenseless and vulnerable. Give to provide medical assistance, to repair homes, to feed and provide shelter.

‘Smell of death thick’ in Gaza air

Al Jazeera reporters touring devastated districts during brief truce speak of decomposing bodies still under rubble.

Residents and journalists venturing out in the Gaza Strip during the early hours of a shaky ceasefire spoke of dozens of decomposing bodies still under rubble caused by Israeli bombardment of the Palestinian enclave.

A short lull of fighting, before after a 72-hour ceasefire agreed by Israel and Hamas collapsed, gave a brief respite to people in the battered strip after more than three weeks of fighting that has killed more than 1,400 Palestinians, mostly civilians.

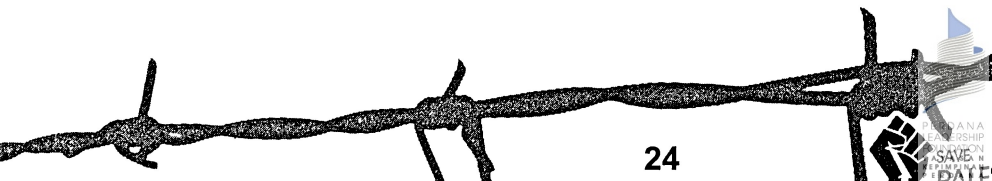
Residents of the flashpoint district of Shujayea, east of Gaza City, were distraught as they returned to the neighbourhood shortly after the ceasefire began. Many found their homes completely flattened by recent violence.

Al Jazeera’s Imtiaz Tyab, reporting from Shujayea, said the destruction was “indescribable”.

“I’ve covered earthquakes, I’ve covered natural disasters, but I’ve never seen devastation like this ... The smell of death is thick in the air”, he said.

The densely populated district of Shujayea came under a heavy Israeli assault on July 20 that left scores dead. Since then, it has been largely abandoned.

‘Cemetery not spared’



The situation in Beit Hanoun in Gaza's northeast was as grim, with rubble covering most of the city's streets. At least 10 buildings had been completely flattened by Israeli bombardment,

Al Jazeera's Wael Dahdouh, reporting from there, said many other buildings had been severely damaged.


"Even the city's cemetery had not been spared," he said. "Residents spoke of bones coming out of the ground of the destroyed cemetery due to the intensity of bombardment."

In the village of Khuzaa, near Gaza's Khan Younis in the south, the sound of shelling could be heard, just hours after the ceasefire officially started.

Ambulances were unable to enter the area to evacuate the injured as the roads were too dangerous,

Al Jazeera's Tamer Meshal, who toured the devastated village, said he saw 20 bodies being pulled out the rubble.

"Many more bodies remain trapped here," he said.
