MALAYSIA-SINGAPORE LEADERS' RETREAT ON 4-5 MAY 2015

Singapore hosted the 6th Annual Leaders' Retreat on 4-5 May 2015. It was participated by both Prime Ministers of Malaysia and Singapore together with several members of Cabinets from both countries.

A Joint Press Conference was held at the end of the 6th Annual Leaders' Retreat on 5 May 2015. A joint statement by the Prime Minister of Malaysia and Prime Minister of Singapore was released during the joint press conference, where both Leaders expressed their satisfaction on the outcome of the Retreat. One of the highlights was the announcement by PM Lee Hsien Loong that the High Speed Rail terminus in Singapore will be located at Jurong East—in Jurong Lake District.

28TH SEA GAMES 2015 IN SINGAPORE

Singapore hosted the 28th SEA Games on 5-16 June 2015. YAB Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin, Deputy Prime Minister of Malaysia, YB Khairy Jamaluddin, Minister of Youth and Sports, together with other officials were in Singapore to cheer on the Malaysia athletes. Datuk Husni Zai Yaacob, High Commissioner of Malaysia to Singapore, along with officers and staff of the High Commission, also spent time to support Malaysia athletes throughout the event. The 2015 SEA Games ended with Malaysia winning a total of 186 medals, with 62 gold, 58 silver and 66 bronze. During the Closing Ceremony, Singapore handed over the SEA Games torch and flag to Malaysia as Malaysia will host the 29th SEA Games in 2017.
